

# Our Pool Rules



Users should not swim alone.



No running, jumping, or diving into the pool.



Check the depth of water before entering the pool.



Check for hazards in the pool.



Avoid holding your breath and swimming long distances underwater.



Boogie boards, surf boards, kayaks are not to be used in the pool.



Please use the toilet before entering the water.

## Important Information

### Key Holder Responsibilities

*Key holders are responsible for the behaviour of anyone admitted to the pool using their key and must ensure that the pool rules are observed.*

- 1 Key holders have the right to ask any non-key holder to leave the pool area.
- 2 Key holders must lock the gate on entering and leaving the pool, and not admit anyone who doesn't have a key.
- 3 Users must produce their key and identify themselves on request.
- 4 Anyone under 16 years of age must be supervised by someone older.
- 5 Key holders must be considerate of other users at the pool. Unruly behaviour will not be tolerated.
- 6 All rubbish must be disposed of in the bin provided.
- 7 Access privileges may be revoked for inappropriate behaviour or disobeying rules.
- 8 In the event of contamination of the pool, the pool must be immediately evacuated, and reported to the school.
- 9 Damage or malfunctioning items must be reported to the school.
- 10 The pool's use is intended for our primary aged children and their older or younger siblings, not for groups of 14 - 17 year olds. Families are asked not to allow groups of teenagers to use the pool as it is not fair on our school aged children.

### Opening Hours

The school pool is available for use by the community during the following hours:

**3:30pm until 8pm**

**Holidays & Weekends:**

**8am until 8pm**
